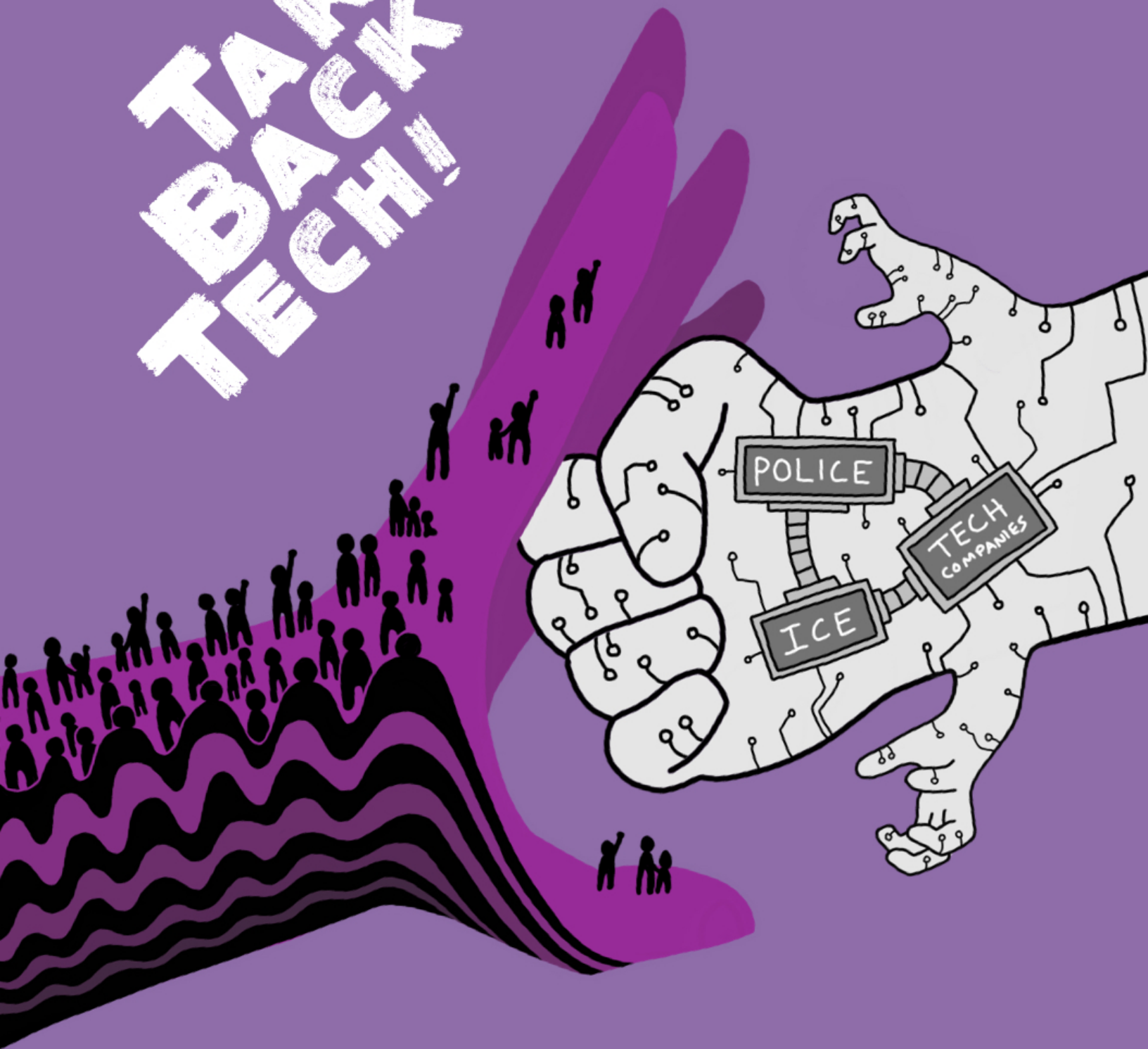


TAKE BACK TECH!

it all started a long time ago...

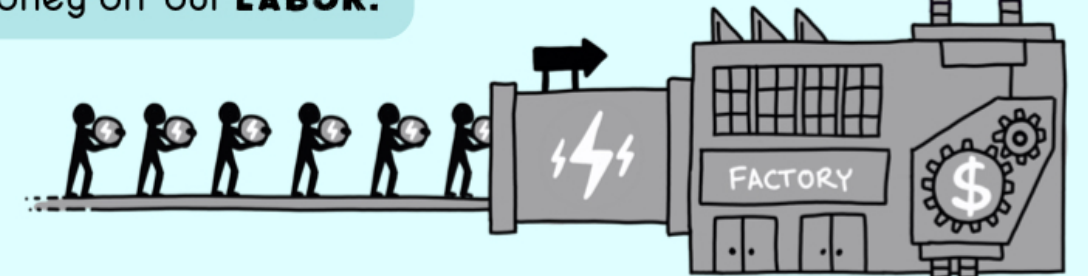


throughout history, people who have valued personal wealth above all else have stolen from us. they steal to **MAKE MONEY.**

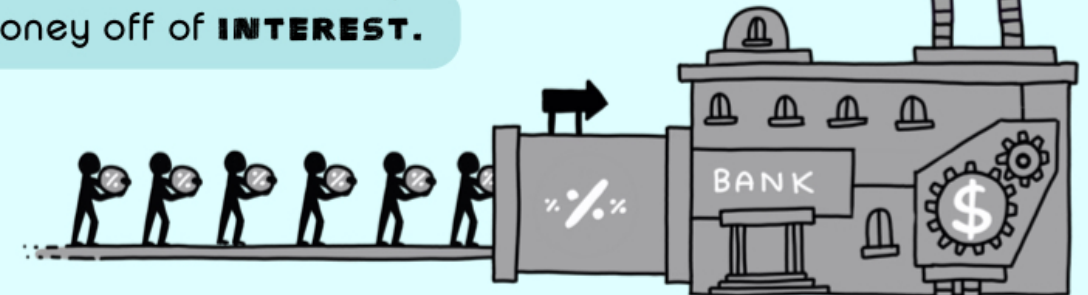
they steal from our Earth, making money off its **RESOURCES.**



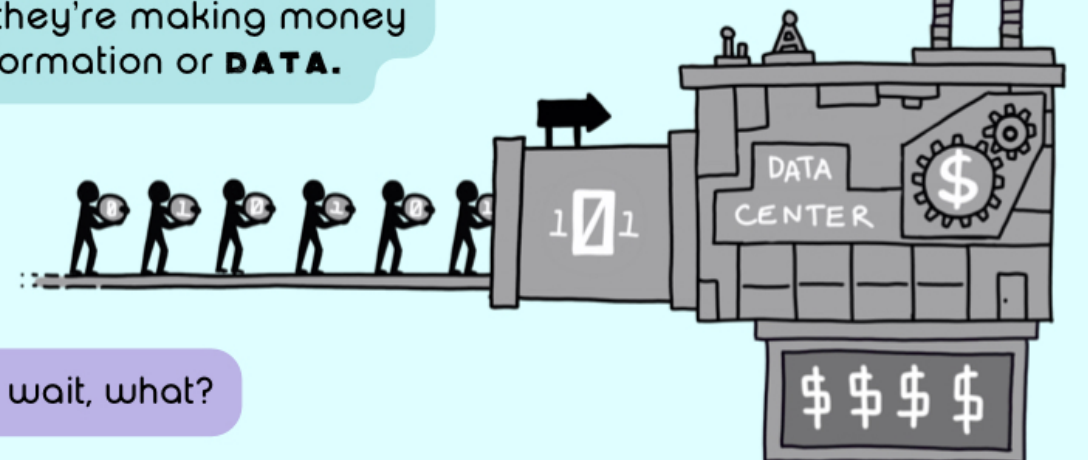
they steal from workers, making money off our **LABOR.**



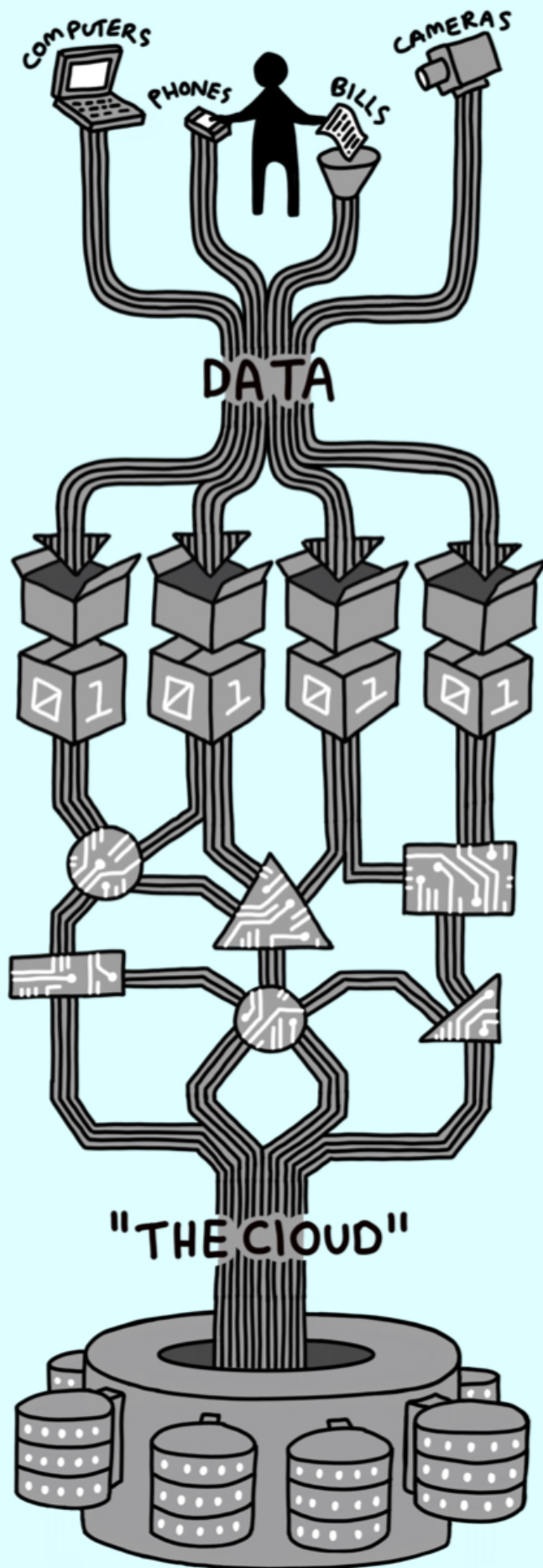
they steal from those with debt, making money off of **INTEREST.**

WHAT?!? HOW??

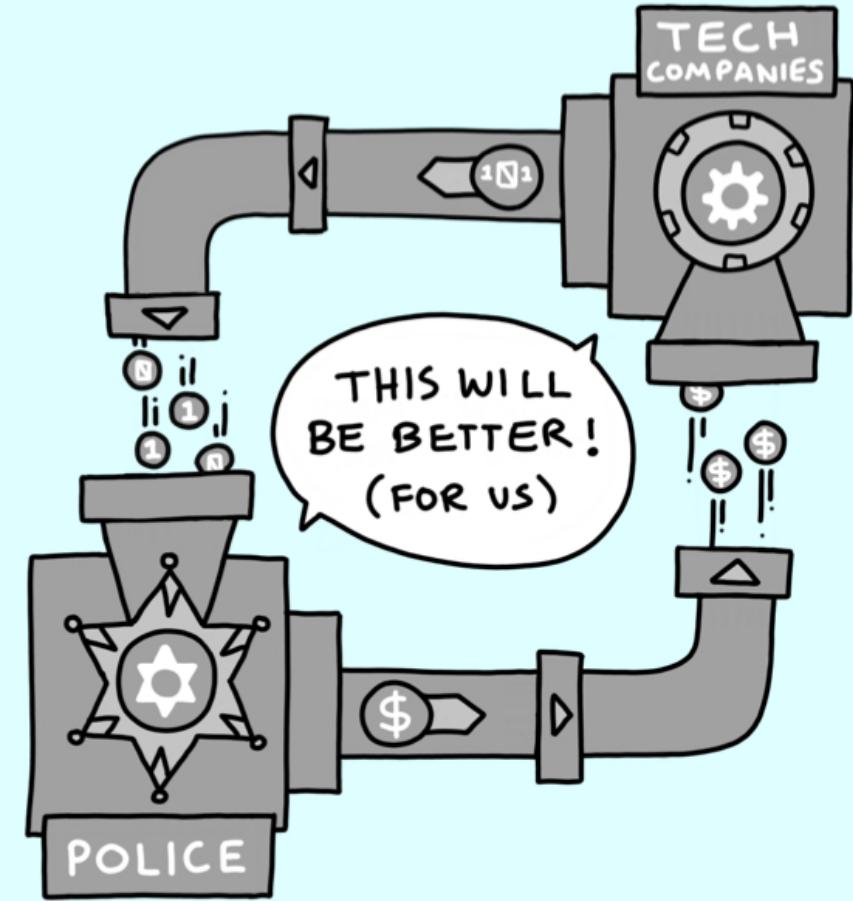
every time we use tech, we create data.

"data brokers" collect data from a bunch of sources and sell it.

companies "analyze" our data to find patterns, so they can make better ads and engage more users.

companies also make money storing this data for as long as they want.

and the worst part is they sell all this data to **POLICE!**

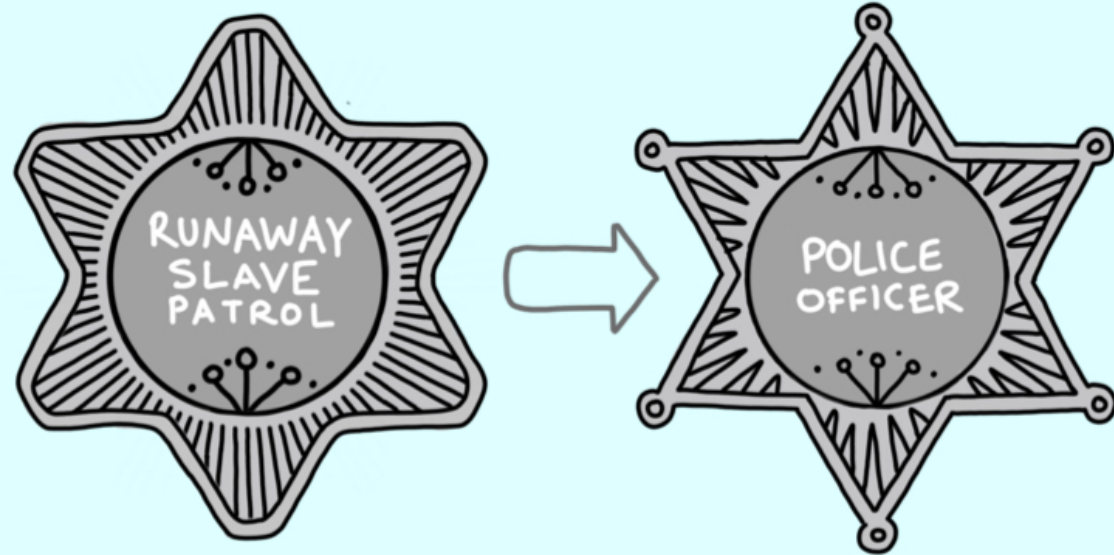


what!! wait, let me guess, police are using our data to keep doing what they always do, except with more people and even more information.

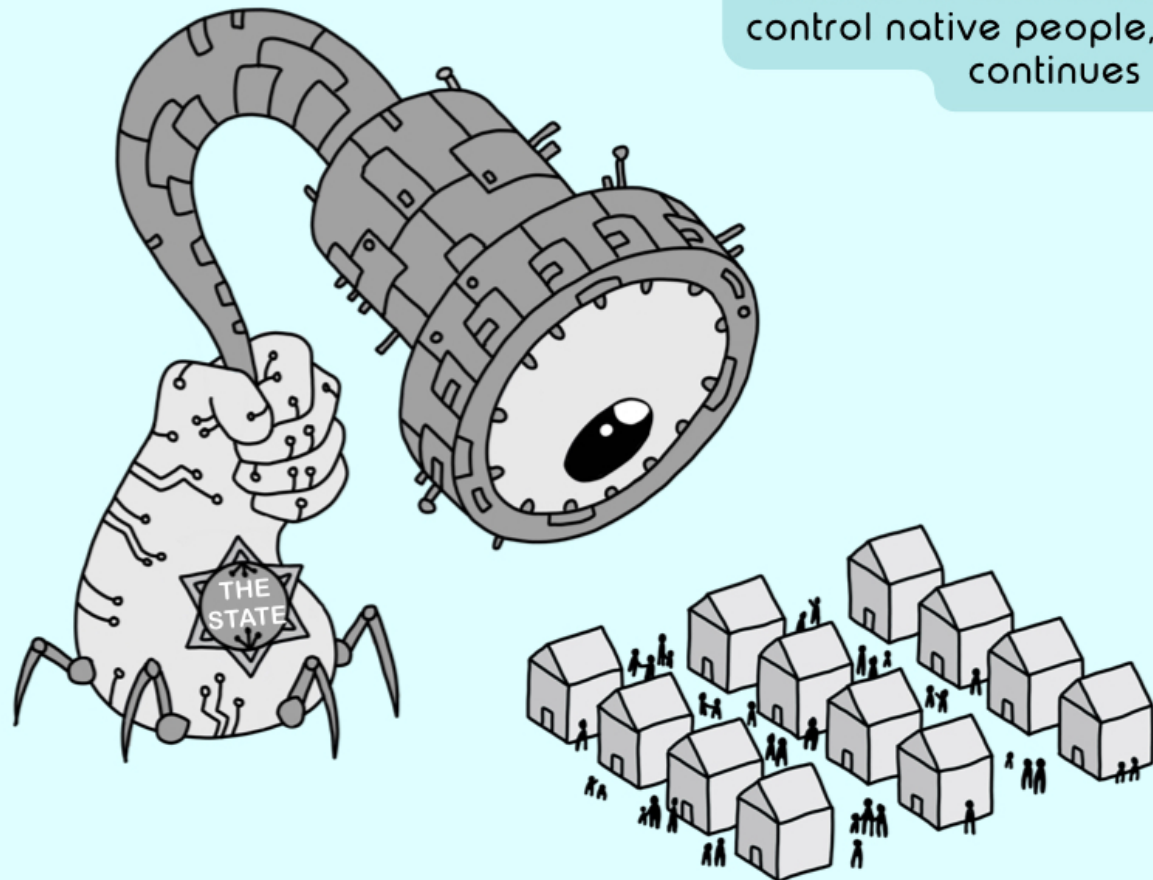
that's right: police and tech companies are building systems of violence and surveillance to control our communities. that's why we're out here **FIGHTING!** because their tactics are evolving, like they always have.

what do you mean?

the first police forces were really **SLAVE CATCHERS**. these groups terrorized black people with random searches and violence, to keep enslaved people from rebelling or escaping.



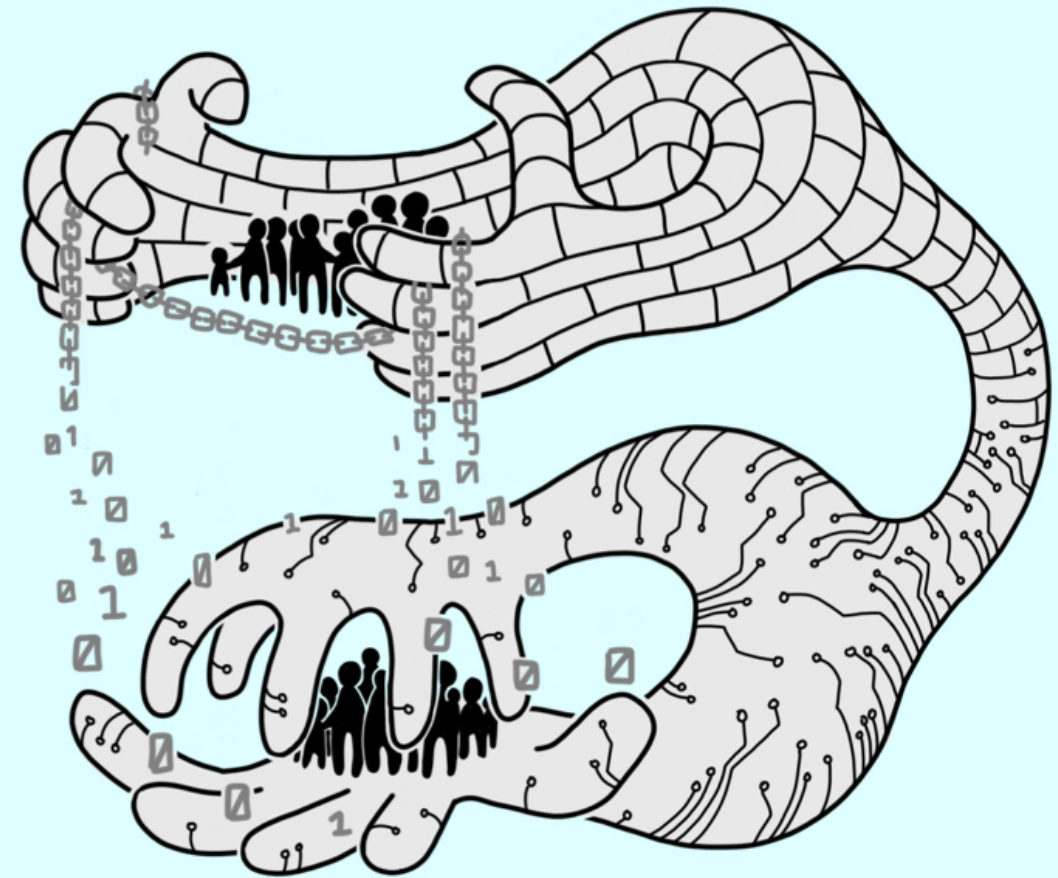
militarized groups also formed so that states could control native people, which continues today.

exactly! and why the US has the **HIGHEST INCARCERATION RATE** in the world.

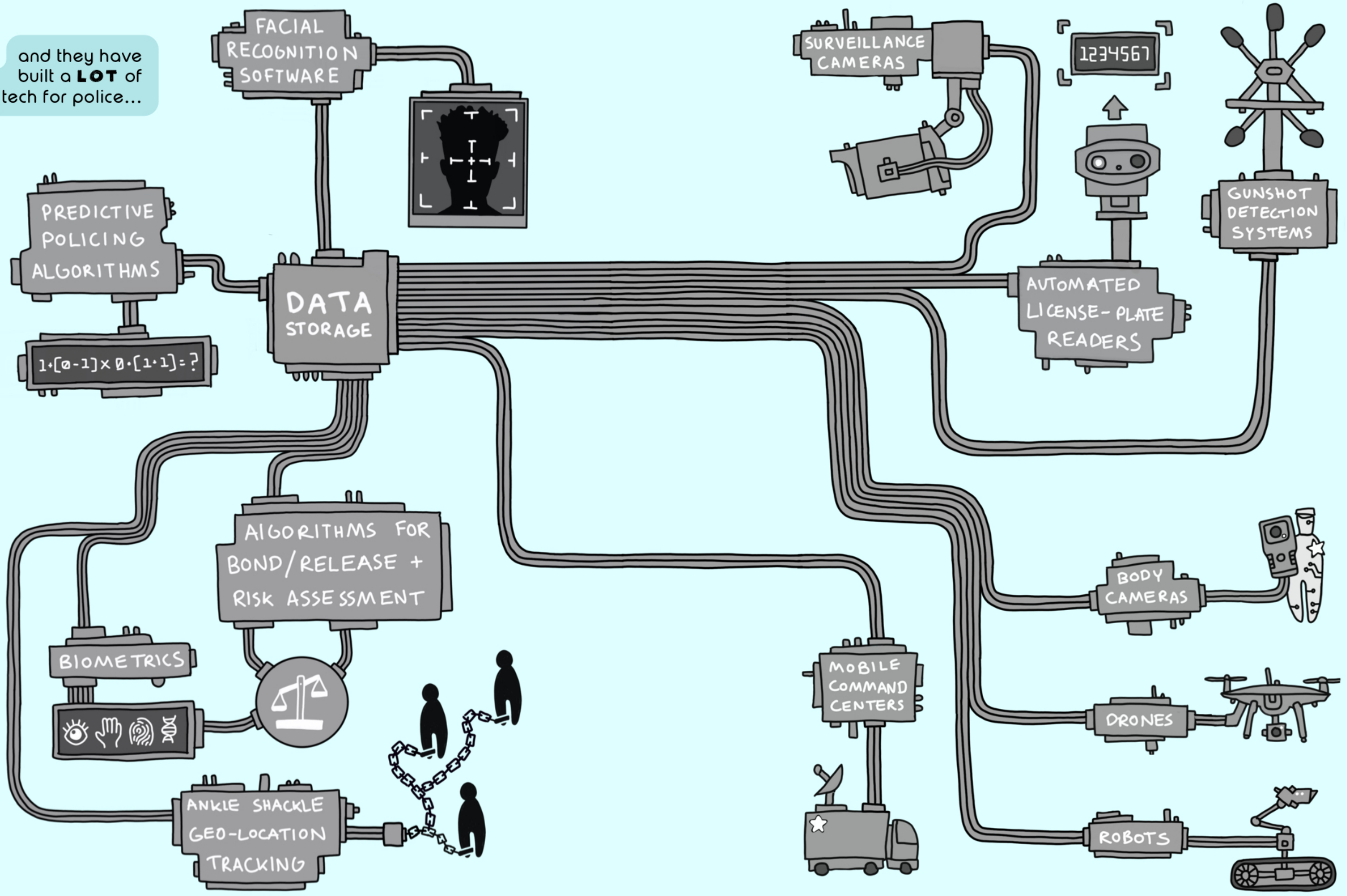


but, haven't folks been fighting back? I know a lot of cities are working to reform the police and reduce their jail size.

yes, our communities have led powerful movements against mass incarceration. but now tech companies are partnering with police and pretending that their tech is a "race neutral alternative".

In reality, tech companies are expanding the reach of the police and making money off building **DIGITAL PRISONS**.

and they have built a **LOT** of tech for police...

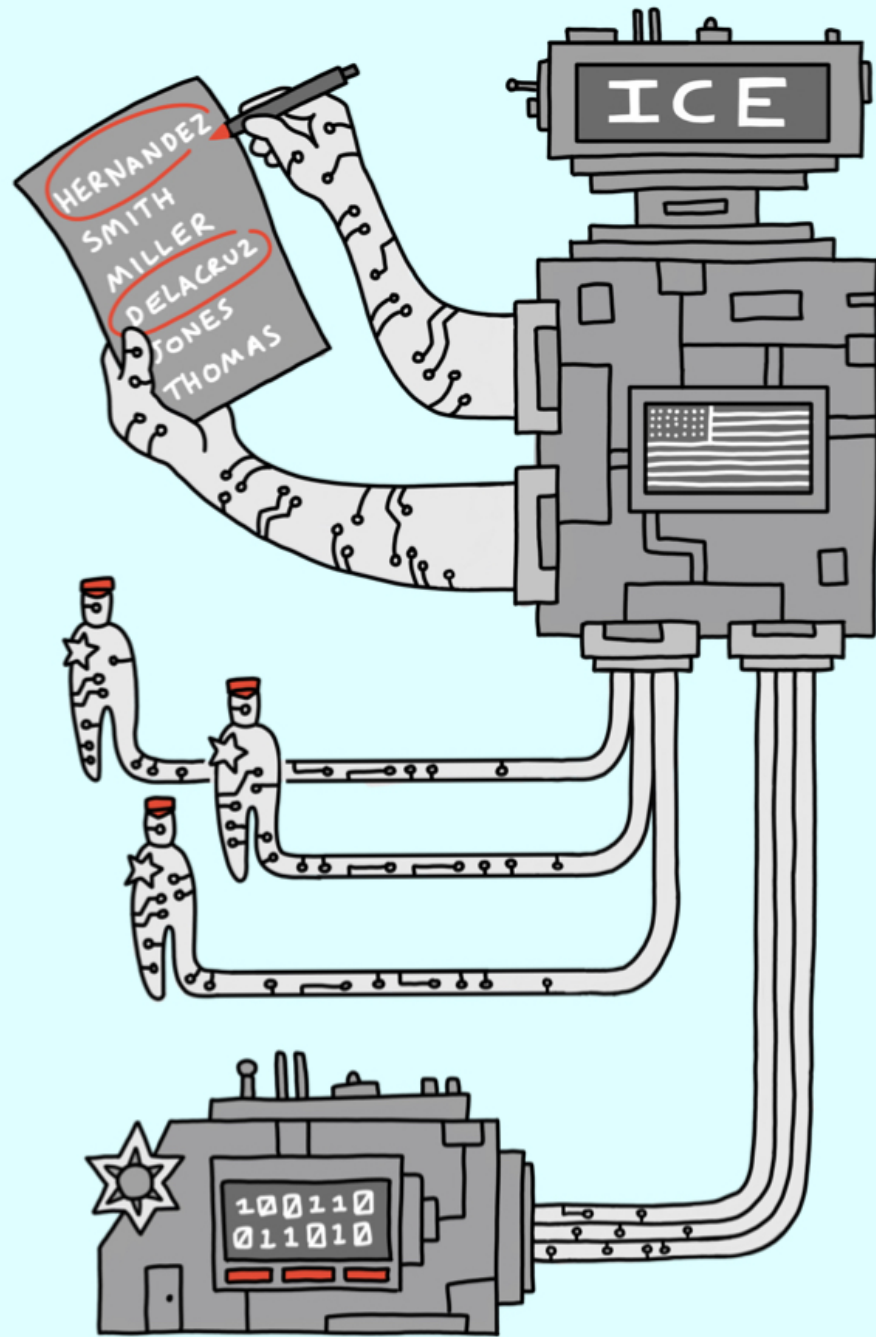




ICE AGENTS are also using data to surveil and detain, more people. there are about 20,000 ICE agents and about 12 million undocumented people, so they are always looking for new ways to increase deportations.

many times they just use racial profiling to find people,

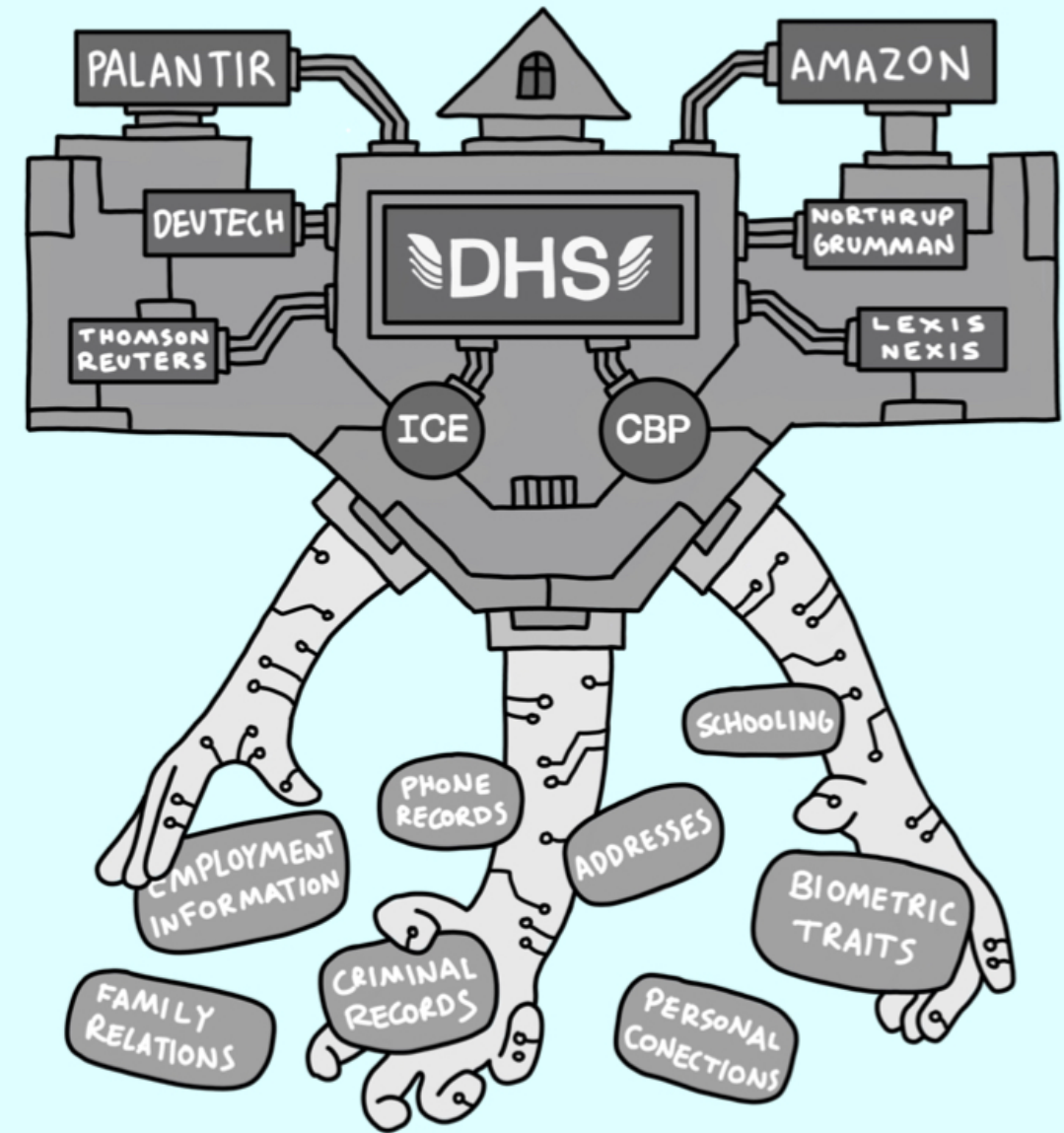
but ICE also works with local police and jails to detain our community.



and now ICE is using data, from both local police and private data brokers, to find undocumented people.



tech companies are helping ICE and CBP use data at a **HUGE** scale and are making tons of money off of it. these are some of the companies that are building ICE's infrastructure:



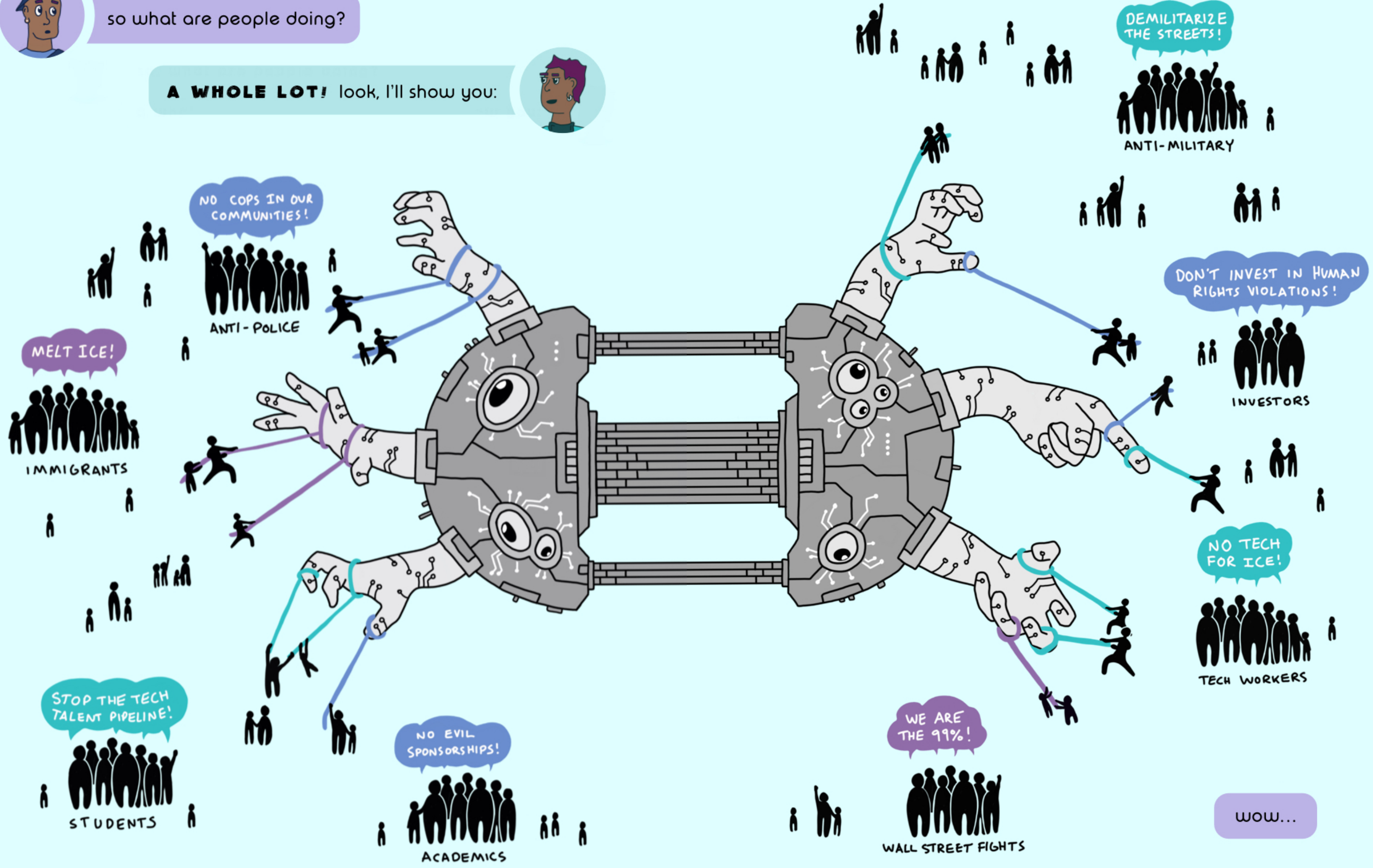
how do we fight this?
